#### 9-Day/8-Night Itinerary

- 1 Depart the U.S. or Canada/Arrive in San José, Costa Rica—Depart home city for San José. Upon arrival, check into the COSTA RICA MARRIOTT HOTEL HACIENDA BELÉN. Enjoy an evening at leisure.
- 2 San José/Puntarenas/Embark the ship—Tour Costa Rica's dynamic capital city of San José and visit the National Theater, a regal Baroque edifice modeled on Milan's La Scala, and the National Museum. After lunch, enjoy a scenic drive to Puntarenas to embark the ship.
- 3 Curú National Wildlife Refuge/Tortuga Island—Enjoy a guided morning walk in the Curú National Wildlife Refuge—comprised of five distinctive untouched habitats. Look for an abundance of wildlife, including howler monkeys, iguanas and more than 230 species of birds. Continue to idyllic Tortuga Island for opportunities to swim and snorkel in this protected island's clear, sheltered waters—home to fascinating marine life such as angelfish, spotted eagle rays and seahorses. Enjoy a Captain's Welcome Reception on board.
- 4 Quepos for Manuel Antonia National Park—Explore
  the protected biodiverse paradise of Manuel Antonio
  National Park, where expert naturalists will help you spot
  colorful toucans; screeching howler monkeys; camouflaged

iguanas; squirrel monkeys; and capuchin monkeys.

- 5 Rio Seco Rainforest—Discover the 400-acre Rio Seco Rainforest, which is part of Piedras Blancas National Park and accessible only by boat. Piedras Blancas National Park is home to toucans; macaws; tapirs; pumas; jaguars; and monkeys. Enjoy a secluded beach along the gorgeous Golfo Dulce and explore a network of hiking trails of various lengths with naturalist tour guides.
- 6 Cébaco, Panama—In the sparkling Gulf of Montijo, snorkel in the emerald waters of seldom-visited Cébaco Island, where schools of brilliantly colored fish, giant manta rays and four different species of turtles swim amid spectacular rock reefs.
- 7 Panama City—Tour the Miraflores Locks Visitor Center, which elaborates on the canal's intricate lock system. Visit the UNESCO World Heritage-designated Historic District of Casco Antiguo, a charming neighborhood replete with architecturally significant historical edifices, including a 16th century cathedral.
- 8 Panama City/Colón—Cruise from the Pacific Ocean to the Caribbean Sea through the mighty locks of the Panama Canal and enjoy a lecture on its history. When completed in

- 1914, this historic engineering marvel opened new channels of international trade by allowing ships to travel between the Atlantic and Pacific Oceans in a fraction of the time required to circumnavigate South America.
- 9 Colón/Agua Clara Visitor Center (time permitting)/ Panama City/ Depart for U.S. or Canada—Disembark in Colón and visit the Panama Canal Expansion Agua Clara Visitor Center to enjoy panoramic views of the canal's new longer, wider locks and impressive, 166-square-mile Gatún Lake. Transfer to Panama City for your return flight home.



- Once-in-a-lifetime daytime passage through the Panama Canal, considered one of the Seven Wonders of the Modern World by the American Society of Civil Engineers.
- Guided tour through rainforests, including Curú National Wildlife Refuge and Manuel Antonio National Park.
- Tour of Panama City, including visits to UNESCO-designated Casco Viejo, the new Frank Gehry-designed Biodiversity Museum and the Panama Canal's informative Miraflores Visitor Center.



- Depart the U.S. or Canada/Arrive in Guayaquil, Ecuador—Transfer to the HILTON COLÓN GUAYAQUIL HOTEL.
- 2 Guayaquil/Fly to San Cristóbal, Galápagos Islands/
  Embark the ship/Kicker Rock—Fly to San Cristóbal,
  one of the oldest islands in the archipelago. Arrive
  at Puerto Baquerizo Moreno, the capital city of the
  Galápagos Islands. See the statue of Charles Darwin
  gracing the harbor before you embark the ship. While
  cruising to Kicker Rock, look out for blue-footed boobies,
  Nazca boobies and frigate birds.
- 3 Isla Bartolomé/Buccaneer Cove, Santiago Island
  See the volcanic moonscape of Isla Bartolomé at
  Sullivan Bay as we anchor nearby. Enjoy beautiful
  panoramas of the black, volcanic cones of Baltra,
  Daphne Major and Daphne Minor as the ship continues
  toward Pinnacle Rock. The day ends at Buccaneer Cove,
  a colorful inlet on Santiago Island that was named after
  some of the first visitors to the area—pirates.
- 4 Punta Vicente Roca, Isabela Island/Punta Espinosa, Fernandina Island—Discover Punta Vicente Roca on Isabela Island, where it is common to see Pacific green turtles. This afternoon, explore the island of Fernandina, which boasts a unique environment with a high density of large marine iguanas.

- 5 Tagus Cove, Isabela Island/Elizabeth Bay—On the northwest coast of Isabela Island, the secluded Tagus Cove was once a favorite anchorage for pirates and whalers. Enjoy an uphill hike to the back of Darwin Crater, filled with salt water. You'll also see Las Mariela's, three rocks at the entrance to Elizabeth Bay, which is favored by blue-footed boobies, flightless cormorants and Galápagos penguins.
- 6 Post Office Bay, Floreana Island/Champion Islet
  See Post Office Bay, the historic barrel where postcards
  are traditionally left for guests from other vessels to
  hand-deliver to their destinations. You will also explore
  Champion Islet, one of four marine sites surrounding
  Floreana. Embark on a Zodiac cruise to see Nazca boobies
  and red-billed tropic birds.
- 7 Santa Cruz Highlands/Breeding Center,
  Puerto Ayora, Santa Cruz Island—See Puerto Ayora,
  Santa Cruz, where the Charles Darwin Research Station
  is located. The station also houses the Fausto Llerena
  Breeding Center for giant tortoises and land iguanas,
  where guides interpret the center's captive breeding and
  reintroduction programs.
- 8 Cerro Dragón/Guy Fawkes Islands/Bahía Borrero
  A dry landing onto volcanic rock covered by Sally Lightfoot
  crabs starts the day with a walk on Cerro Dragon
  (Dragon Hill). Later, enjoy snorkeling among
  multi-colored tropical fish, turtles and seals. The day of

- touring concludes at Bahía Borrero, a white coralline beach used as a nesting site by green sea turtles. Enjoy the Captain's Farewell Reception that evening.
- 9 San Cristóbal, Galápagos Islands/Disembark ship/ Fly to Guayaquil, Ecuador—Fly from San Cristóbal to Guayaquil for an afternoon at leisure.
- 10 Return home to the U.S. or Canada

- 2 Paris, France/Honfleur/Embark the ship—Transfer to Honfleur and embark the ship. Enjoy a presentation from Professor Dwight David Eisenhower II, who shares personal stories about his grandfather and Operation Overlord—the Allies' code name for the military campaign that launched the D-Day airborne and amphibious invasion at Normandy on June 6, 1944. Attend dinner on board this evening.
- 3 Caen for Arromanches and Omaha Beach—Drive to Longues-sur-Mer, where the coastal German artillery battery remains intact. Continue to Omaha Beach, where Allied forces landed on June 6, 1944, and walk the historic Normandy shores. Then, in the company of Professor Eisenhower, contemplate the solemn commemorative crosses and Stars of David in the American military cemetery at Colleville-sur-Mer. Conclude your day with the Captain's Welcome Reception.
- 4 Cherbourg Visit Pointe du Hoc and continue to the Church of Angoville-au-Plain to view its stained-glass rendition of the American Airborne parachute drop.


  Nearby, visit Utah Beach and the Utah Beach D-Day Museum. In Sainte-Mère-Èglise, one of the first French villages to be liberated by American forces during World War II, see its famous church, where American

- soldier John Steele caught his parachute on the steeple and "played dead" for two hours before being taken prisoner.
- 5 Tresco, Isles of Scilly, United Kingdom—Visit the family-owned island of Tresco, famed for its 19<sup>th</sup>-century Tresco Abbey Gardens, built around the ruins of a Benedictine Abbey. Explore the garden's Valhalla Museum, home to an eclectic collection of 30 shipwrecked figureheads recovered across the Isles of Scilly.
- 6 Dublin, Ireland—Enjoy a panoramic tour of Dublin, featuring St. Patrick's and Christ Church cathedrals and grand O'Connell Street, lined with statues of Irish statesmen. Stroll through quadrangles of Trinity College, founded in 1592. Enjoy a traditional Irish music and dance presentation on board this evening.
- 7 Holyhead, Wales, for Caernarfon—From Holyhead, transfer across the quaint Isle of Anglesey and over the Menai Strait to North Wales, the cradle of Celtic culture, where Welsh remains the mother tongue. Visit beautiful Bodnant Garden and experience the grandeur of the UNESCO World Heritage-designated Caernarfon Castle, a 13th-century fortress built by Edward I of England as a defense against the marauding Welsh.
- 8 Isle of Iona/Tobermory, Isle of Mull—Visit the inner Hebridean Isle of Iona, the birthplace of Christianity in Scotland, to see its restored abbey and intricate Celtic

- crosses. Later, join Allen Packwood OBE on board the ship as he discusses the complexity of the D-Day operations and Sir Winston Churchill's role in its undertaking.
- **9 Kyle of Lochalsh**—Enjoy views of the Black and Red Cuillin mountain ranges at Sligachan and the heather-woven hills and rocky shorelines of Sleat, the "Garden of Skye." Visit 13<sup>th</sup>-century Eilean Donan Castle, magnificently sited at the entrance to Loch Duich. Conclude your evening with the Captain's Farewell Reception on board.
- 10 Glasgow, Scotland/Greenock/Disembark ship/ Return to the U.S. or Canada



- ◆ Two full-day excursions to the D-Day beaches of Normandy with visits to Utah and Omaha Beaches, Sainte-Mére-Èglise, including a tour of the American military cemetery with Dwight David Eisenhower II, grandson of General and President Dwight D. Eisenhower.

- 4 Wrangell—Walk through Wrangell's quaint downtown to Kiks.ádi Totem Park and discover the history of these intricately carved totem poles. Transfer to Petroglyph Beach, a state historic beach home to rock carvings created 8,000 years ago. Later, visit the Wrangell Museum, where more

- than 5,000 artifacts and exhibits display the local trades in Alaska—fishing, mining and logging.
- 5 Sitka—In Sitka, visit the Alaska Raptor Center,
  Alaska's foremost bald eagle habitat where more than
  100 injured eagles are rehabilitated and released
  each year. Explore Sitka National Historical Park,
  where artists demonstrate their totemic art forms, and
  enjoy opportunities to walk the forest trails or converse
  with native artists. Visit St. Michael's Cathedral,
  North America's first Russian Orthodox church.
- 6 Elfin Cove/Point Adolphus—Go ashore to explore pristine Chichagof Island and visit the small fishing community of Elfin Cove. Situated across from Glacier Bay National Park with a population of only 20 permanent residents, this hamlet flourishes in summer with fishing enthusiasts. From the observation deck, search for humpback whales and orcas feeding in the nutrient-rich waters of Point Adolphus while cruising through Icy Strait, where tidal waters teem with marine life. Watch for sea lions and bald eagles drawn by the abundance of salmon.
- 7 Tracy Arm Fjord/Sawyer Glacier/Endicott Fjord/ Dawes Glacier—Cruise into the deep and narrow fjord of Tracy Arm, where waterfalls cascade from bluffs, forests fade to sheer rock and icebergs glint in the sunlight. In Endicott Arm Fjord, look for harbor seals hauled out on ice platforms, and inquisitive whales and

- bears hunting for fish. At the remote end of Tracy Arm, listen to ice calving off the soaring South Sawyer Glacier. Venture to the edge of Dawes Glacier aboard. Attend the Captain's Farewell Reception on board the ship this evening.
- 8 Juneau/Disembark ship/Return home to the U.S. or Canada




